Motion to approve minutes by Chad and James approved unanimously.

 - a. Treasurer's Report

- Close to expectations for the year. \$170,000 in the bank with few bills left.
 Estimated \$10,000 less than last year because of some unexpected repairs and improvements.
- For consideration: Numbers for Nonprofits assistance with capital campaign.
- Capital campaign progress: Ski Club Pro edit for it appearing first in line.
- \$40,000 contract from Jeremy Witek and ask for 10% down payment. Concerns are what is scope and sticking to the budget.
 - b. Renewal of the accounting contract

\$16,000 for Numbers for Nonprofits annual contract. Motion to approve contract by Ken & James. Approved unanimously.

VI. Membership

- a. Continued Discussion: Membership categories/pricing & Club Identity [Amy]
- Recap from February to address growing pains from summer program growth.
- From board proposals: Consider reservation time slots for bike riding.
- Kelley L countered the idea of no free riding during lessons. Kelley wants
 whole families and kids and all members active at that time. Kelley wants
 that to also help kids learn etiquette.
- The general consensus is for pricing changes to be pro-family more than for individuals.
- April 1 to October 31 consensus for season. Winter bikers need to get a year-round no tow membership.
- Motion to adopt \$25 student, \$45 individual, and \$90 family memberships.
 Motion to accept new policy by Ken, seconded by Joe approved unanimously.
 - b. Mountain Bike Membership proposal [Pat]
- Proposal from Pat Remington: "We recommend that we increase the rates from \$50 family/\$25 single to \$80 family/\$40 single/\$20 student."
 Considerations: This is a big increase from last year, and might lead to few members (20-30% drop from the 1,000+ membership last year?), but the same or more income. Moving from a summer-only to year-round

membership may encourage people to pay the higher fees. The addition of a student membership is like other membership categories and supports the focus on getting kids into sports.
