 - 4. Capital campaign needs to offset the well costs so our savings is not completely depleted
 - 5. If we update our membership cap, we could raise another ~\$10k (15 families). Lessons are full. Private lessons are possible but already a popular option. Consensus is NOT to increase capacity at this moment but reconsider in the future. Main limiting factor is the First Flight lesson capacity. Possibly we could make better use of the eastside with the more advanced kids in the future.
